Ways to Register

- ♦ Walk in to register at the City of Mt. Pleasant Parks and Recreation Office, located in City Hall at 320 W. Broadway Street, Mt. Pleasant. The office is open Monday through Friday, from 8:00 am to 4:30 pm. The phone number is 989-779-5331. Accepted methods of payment include cash, check or credit card. A small convenience fee will be assessed for credit card payments.
- ♦ Mail in your check or money order with the completed registration form to: Mt. Pleasant Parks and Recreation, 320 W. Broadway, Mt. Pleasant, MI 48858. Make checks payable to MPPR.
- ♦ Online registration is available by clicking [HERE](#). A small convenience fee will be assessed for credit card payments.



Activity Registration

Make sure to provide all information requested, including family member detail and activity code. Some programs may require additional information, which will be explained in the program detail. Include any special requests when registering.

Early Discount

Many programs have an early registration discount. Be early and SAVE!

Resident Discount

Most programs have a resident discount. When you reside or own property inside the city limits, you qualify for the resident discount.

Refund Policy

All classes and activities cancelled by MPPR before the start of a program will be refunded in full. Participants requesting a refund before the start of a program are entitled to a refund less an \$8 service fee. No refunds are available once a program has begun.

Photo Policy

On occasion, our staff may photograph or videotape participants in programs or at special events. These photographs and video are for our use only and may be used in publications, brochures, pamphlets, flyers or video production.

Weather Policy

In the case of inclement weather, updates will be posted on the Parks & Recreation website, Facebook, and on the weather hotline. Cancellations will be made as far in advance as possible, but if cancellation has not been made 30 minutes prior to program, determination will be made at the program.
