Instructions:

1. The City of Mt. Pleasant, Michigan, is requesting sealed bids for sand and gravel at the Office of the City Clerk, City Hall, 401 N. Main Street, Mt. Pleasant, Michigan 48858, until 1:30 p.m. on Tuesday, March 25, 2008. All bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope, plainly marked "2008 Sand and Gravel Bid – March 25, 2008".

2. Specifications are available at the Public Works building, 1303 N. Franklin Street, Mt. Pleasant, Michigan 48858, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. or on the City's website at <http://www.mt-pleasant.org/depts/engineering/biddinginfo.htm>.

3. Any questions pertaining to the quotation documents shall be directed to Robert Murphy, Street Superintendent, (989) 779-5409, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

4. The quote shall be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder based on the ability to meet the specifications and special provisions of the quotation documents. Each item will be awarded separately based on these criteria.

5. The City of Mt. Pleasant reserves the right to accept or reject any or all quotations, to waive any irregularities in the quotes, and to select the quote considered most advantageous to the city.

Specifications:

1. All materials shall meet **2003 MDOT Standard Specifications** for Construction:

SAND - Sand, Class II

GRAVEL - 22A Gravel

2. All prices shall be considered firm from May 1, 2008 to April 30, 2009.
3. Unit prices shall include delivery to the City of Mt. Pleasant material storage yard located at 1303 N. Franklin Street, Mt. Pleasant, Michigan 48858, or at such work site so specified within the city limits.
4. All bidders are required to state their source of each material quote to enable confirmation of conformance with noted specifications.
5. The successful bidder shall provide and deliver material within a 24-hour period from the time of request by the Street Superintendent or other such delegate.
6. All material deliveries are to be accompanied by weight tickets from a state certified weight scale.
