**TRADE YOUR TREASURES**  
**RESIDENTIAL LARGE ITEM COLLECTION PROGRAM**



The City of Mt. Pleasant will be conducting a residential large item collection program entitled, "TRADE YOUR TREASURES" beginning September 6, 2008. The program will include an opportunity for residents to exchange unwanted items by placing them at the curb for trading on Saturday and Sunday, September 6 - 7, 2008. City residents are encouraged to call 779-5401 with their list of unwanted items. This list will be posted on the City website and cable channel, so that others may find and take them during the trading period. **Property owners/residents are responsible for the proper disposal of all items not claimed during the weekend of September 6 - 7, 2008.** Items placed at the curbside shall at no time obstruct any City sidewalk, street, or view of traffic.

To have items picked up by the City on Friday, September 12, 2008, residents must sign up and purchase sticker(s) at the Division of Public Works building, 1303 N. Franklin Street, or at City Hall, 401 N. Main Street. The cost of the stickers is \$10.00/item for items that do not contain Freon and \$35.00/item for items that contain Freon. Application and payment of fees must be made by 4:30 p.m., Thursday, September 11, 2008. All items intended for pick up must be placed at the curb by 7:30 a.m., on Friday, September 12, 2008, with the designated collection sticker on them. **NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED.**

Items that will be accepted through this program include: furniture, appliances, television sets, and other large items generated in a residential household but that are not currently collectable under the City's bag/tag program and **weigh no more than 50 pounds**. Under the following conditions, items acceptable for pick up include: building materials that are bundled in no longer than four foot (4') lengths and weigh no more than 50 pounds with the nails removed, dry carpet rolls that are bundled in no longer than four foot (4') lengths and weigh no more than 50 pounds, and water softeners with the salt removed. This program will accept appliances that contain Freon. **Refrigerators and freezers must have the doors tightly secured.** Unacceptable items include, but are not limited to: pianos, hot tubs, or any item weighting 50 plus pounds, automobile tires, clothing, and small miscellaneous items.

Residents are expected to read and follow the guidelines as set forth above. Failure to comply with the guidelines and restrictions of the program will result in forfeiture of the fees paid, and the property owner/resident will be responsible for removing uncollected items from the public right-of-way in a timely manner. Storage of collected items must meet City guidelines. Please direct questions to the Division of Public Works office at 779-5401, or the Code Enforcement office at 779-5302.
