Several large jets came in, including a G4 last week. The G4 is one of the largest to come into Mt. Pleasant.

The Young Eagles flight last Saturday was a very good day. "Always a good day flying when no one gets sick." Benzinger stated he had to put \$20 of his own money to cover the snacks that disappeared.
