Robbery suspect arrested, held on unrelated charges in Gratiot County

MT. PLEASANT, Mich. Feb. 27, 2015 – Mt. Pleasant police officers responded to a robbery about 3:40 a.m. Feb. 27 at the 7-11 store, 2397 S. Mission Road. Police gathered evidence and interviewed the night clerk, who was able to provide a detailed description of the suspect and his vehicle, which was shared with law enforcement agencies.

A short time later, a Gratiot County Sherriff's deputy stopped a vehicle matching the description of the robbery suspect and arrested a 21-year-old Mt. Pleasant man on unrelated charges. He is currently being held in Gratiot County on those charges – and will not be arraigned on charges stemming from the Mt. Pleasant robbery today.

Investigators believe the man entered the 7-11 and demanded money with his hand in a bag, claiming he had a weapon; however, a weapon was never seen or recovered. He then fled in a dark four-door Sedan south on US-127 and attempted to dispose of evidence by throwing it onto the freeway. The evidence was later recovered by officers from the Mt. Pleasant Police Department.

Mt. Pleasant police obtained a two count felony warrant today for the suspect arrest. One count is robbery armed and one count is robbery unarmed. Investigators are still processing evidence and completing search warrants involving the incident.
