**APPLICATION FOR LAWN WATERING CREDIT FOR CITY PROJECTS**

To help with the cost of watering newly seeded areas disturbed by City projects, the Division of Public Works established a lawn watering credit program to encourage residents to water and maintain the newly seeded areas once the construction project in their area is complete. Residents interested in receiving a credit of 5,000 gallons of water on their water bill must commit to care for the lawn and submit the completed application.

**Recommended Lawn Care Instructions**  
(Detach for reference)

1. Water

The first 14 days are critical! Keep the newly seeded lawn moist, not soaked, at all times by sprinkling it once per day. Take care not to overwater though. Germinating seeds will die if they dry out, but also will do so if they are overwatered.

2. Mow

Mow as soon as the grass is 2" to 3" high, then at least once per week thereafter. Delaying the first cutting will cause the grass blades to bend over and make the lawn less dense. Avoid brown spots by keeping the mower blades sharp to prevent bruised and torn grass.
