

PEAK After School FAQ's

Who can attend PEAK?

Children, grades K-6, will discover the awesome benefits of education, recreation, and service learning through a variety of daily activities: sports, arts, crafts, creative expression, cultural and educational enrichments.

When is PEAK offered?

PEAK follows the Mt. Pleasant Public Schools calendar. PEAK will be offered on all full days of school. PEAK is closed on school holidays, snow days, professional development days or early dismissal, scheduled or otherwise.

Where is PEAK held?

PEAK After School is held at the following Mt. Pleasant Public Schools: Ganiard, Fancher, McGuire, Pullen, and Vowles Elementaries.

Is bussing available?

Transportation is the responsibility of the parent/guardian; bussing is not available. Children need to be signed out by 6:00 p.m. each day. ICTC may be contacted for transportation services at 989-772-9441. It is the parent's/guardian's responsibility to contact ICTC; please indicate a pick-up time of 5:30 p.m. or earlier, when utilizing ICTC services.

Is there a snack provided?

The program will provide an afternoon snack each day. If your child has specific food needs, please send your own.

What is academic time?

Time is set aside for homework assistance Monday-Thursday. Participants who do not have homework will participate in hands-on educational related activities.

What is enrichment time?

A variety of recreational enrichment time activities are available from which to choose. Refer to your PEAK site individual flyer for a calendar and a complete description of available enrichment activities. Enrichment activity fees (for activities such as Girls on the Run), if any, will be announced in advance.

What is a Fun Friday?

Fun Fridays consist of special events, movies, assemblies, and local area field trips. All on-site activities are closed when field trips are planned. Participants must attend the field trip or find an alternate activity for that day; the site will be closed. Field trip fees, if any, will be announced in advance.

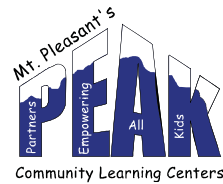

Enrollment Process:

Advance registration is required. All enrollments will be taken at the Mt. Pleasant Parks and Recreation Office in City Hall, by mail or walk in, using the attached registration form. An individual registration form must be completed for each child and submitted prior to attendance. Please allow 48 hours to process your registration.

Payment Schedule:

Payment for the first two weeks is due at the time of enrollment and should be submitted to the Mt. Pleasant Parks and Recreation Office. Weekly payments are due each Friday thereafter and will be accepted at the PEAK site. Services must be paid in exact amounts. Check or cash payments accepted. Past due balances may result in suspension of services. Contact our office at 989-779-5331 to make payment arrangements.

Late Pick Up:

You will be assessed a \$5 per child late fee for the first 10 minutes you are late picking up your child(ren) and an additional \$1.00 for every minute thereafter.

Scholarships:

It is the goal of the PEAK After School Program for all children to be able to attend after school educational and enrichment programs regardless of personal financial situation. Scholarships are awarded according to the Free and Reduced Lunch Income Guidelines; verification required. If you do not meet Free and Reduced Lunch Income Guidelines, and are in need of financial assistance, you may complete a Scholarship Application, which is available at the Parks and Recreation Office.

Assistance for Special Needs:

PEAK provides an educational and fun outlet for people of all abilities. Persons with disabilities needing assistance to participate may call the Parks and Recreation Office at 989-779-5331. Seven day advance notice is necessary for accommodation. Persons requiring speech or hearing assistance may contact the City through the Michigan Relay Center at 1-800-649-3777.
