Structure Fire Press Release

On Saturday January 23, 2016 at 7:46 am the Mt. Pleasant Fire Department was dispatched to a possible structure fire at Central Concrete Products located at 900 S. Bradley Street. Central Concrete Products, Inc. is Mid-Michigan's premier ready mixed concrete supplier, with two plant locations in Mt. Pleasant and Alma, Michigan. The building was closed during the time of the fire and unoccupied by personnel.

We responded with two Engines, a Rescue, a Ladder and several support vehicles. First arriving units encountered heavy smoke and fire conditions and observed a partial collapse of the roof. A defensive exterior attack was established because of the instability of the structure. Due to the size of the facility and amount of fire conditions present, we requested assistance from the Saginaw Chippewa Tribal Fire Department and Shepherd Tri-Township Fire Department at the scene and the Deerfield Fire Department to cover our station in the event we received another emergency. We also received assistance from the Mt. Pleasant Police Department, Isabella County Sheriff Department, Michigan Department of Transportation, Mobile Medical Response and the Shepherd Tri-Township Firefighters Auxiliary.

In total 41 firefighters brought the fire under control at approximately 9:00 am although they remained on location until 11:42 am extinguishing any lingering hot spots.

One Mt. Pleasant Firefighter required several stitches after he was struck in the face by an object.
