CMU student arrested on arson charges

MT. PLEASANT, Mich. April 24, 2015 – Mt. Pleasant Police officers arrested a 21-year-old Central Michigan University student from Wyandotte today on charges of arson and disorderly conduct. The charges stem from a fire investigation on April 18 at the intersection of Franklin and Gaylord streets. Officers were investigating a “house crawl” event, which was promoted on twitter over the weekend.

This is the second CMU student arrested for arson in the past two months. The first CMU student was arrested on St. Patrick’s Day. Both men face criminal charges as well as possible sanctions from CMU’s Office of Student Conduct. The minimum sanction outlined in the Student Code of Conduct is suspension from the university up to dismissal.

The suspect is being held at the Isabella County Jail. Bond has been set at \$10,000/ten percent.
