

Trail Sharing Safety Guidelines



The City of Mt. Pleasant's impressive trail system is available to individuals of all abilities. Visitors must follow all park rules and regulations.

To safely share the trails with others, follow these guidelines:

- Multi-use trails are available to walkers, runners, hikers, dog-walkers, wheelchairs, bicyclists, bladers, skaters and skateboarders.
- Observe trail speed limits.
- Do not block the trail.
- Travel on the right side of the trail; pass on the left.
- Announce yourself as you are passing another trail user.
- Lookout for other trail users as well as maintenance and emergency vehicles.
- Listen. For safety reasons, wear only one earbud when listening to devices.
- Do not venture off the trails. Protect the park's natural vegetation.
- Pick up your trash and animal waste.
- Keep dogs on a leash, not to exceed six feet.
- Bicyclists, dogs and their owners, must yield to wheelchairs, strollers and pedestrians.
