Notice is hereby given that the Mt. Pleasant City Commission will conduct public hearings as follows:

- 1) To receive public input on proposed amendment to Chapter 110. GENERAL LICENSING to allow for and regulate the operation of pedicabs within the City.
- 2) To obtain public input on the Michigan Economic Development Corporation (MEDC) Revitalization and Placemaking Grant proposal.
- 3) To receive public input on proposed amendment to Title XI: BUSINESS REGULATIONS, Chapter 112. Medical Marihuana Facilities of the Mt. Pleasant Code of Ordinances to remove the current caps in place for marihuana businesses and instead allow for an unlimited number of businesses to operate within the City boundaries.
- 4) To receive public input on proposed amendment to Title XI: BUSINESS REGULATIONS, Chapter 115. Recreational Marihuana Establishments of the Mt. Pleasant Code of Ordinances to remove the current caps in place for marihuana businesses and instead allow for an unlimited number of businesses to operate within the City boundaries.

In an effort to slow the spread of COVID-19, and following recommendations of state and county health officials and the Center for Disease Control & Prevention (CDC), the Public Hearing will be held in person with virtual attendance options available.
